Volunteer Firefighter/Medic Minimum Requirements

Must be eighteen (18) years of age or older.

Must have High School Diploma or GED equivalent.

No felony convictions or disqualifying criminal histories within the past seven (7) years.

Must be a valid United States Citizen.

Must be able to read, write and understand the English language.

Must be of good moral character and of temperate and have industrious habits.

Must be able to meet department physical standards.

Ability to obtain Firefighter I and CPR certifications and any others certifications required by the Fire Chief.

Required physical activities

Driving, climbing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, walking, lifting, reaching, talking, hearing, grasping, and finger dexterity, repetitive motions.

Vision Requirements

The minimum standard for use with those whose work deals largely with preparing and analyzing data and figures, accounting, transcriptions, computer terminal and extensive reading.

Environmental Conditions

Work is performed in a typical office environment. The worker is not substantially exposed to adverse Environmental Conditions.

Physical Characteristics of Work

Work involves sitting 80% of the time.

Standing approximately 8% of the time.

Walking approximately 8% of the time.

Driving approximately 4% of the time.

Vision Testing

Audio Testing

Blood Values Test

Pulmonary Function Test

Electro Cardiogram Evaluation

Full set of diagnostic Vitals Check

Qualitative SCBA and Heppa Mask Fit Test

If there are any pre-existing medical conditions or chronic issues that Fire Chief or Work-Comp insurance find to be questionable and that could interfere with your ability to perform duties, a more extensive physical exam can be requested.
